MINUTES

March 19, 2012

PROGRAM: Joe Kirby of *The Marietta Daily Journal* and author of the book *The Lockheed Plant* was guest speaker. Mr. Kirby gave a slide presentation showing a pictorial view of the 60 years history of the Lockheed plant in Marietta. When built it was the largest manufacturing plant south of the Mason-Dixon Line. He spoke of the 28,000 employees who built the first B29 and B52 Bombers in the plant during WWII. Following the war, the plant closed and there were only 79 workers remaining. The plant was then used as a storage facility.

During the Korean War the plant re-opened to recondition the B29s. Employees numbered 4000. Jimmy Carmichael was plant manager.

The first C130 Hercules rolled out in 1954 and the 200th C130 (C130J model) rolled out in 2010. Currently the F35 is partially being built at the plant. Over the history of the plant the C141 Starlifter, the C5 Galaxy, the Jet Star, P3 Orion, the X4 Hummingbird, the XB70 and F22 Rapture were built.

TREASURER'S REPORT: Judy Clark reported a balance of \$6242.16 as of February 29, 2012. Motion was made by David Stone with a second to accept the report. Motion carried.

MINUTES: The minutes of February 20, 2012 were printed and presented. Motion was made by Lynda Edwards with a second to approve the minutes. Motion carried.
